Available Position:

Chatham-Kent Health Alliance (CKHA) has an immediate opportunity for a Paediatrician to join a group of consulting general paediatricians. Neonatal experience is required for this exciting opportunity.

The obstetrical unit at CKHA delivers approximately 1000 infants annually and electively delivers infants at 32 weeks gestation and over. Paediatricians manage a Level II B nursery and a 3 bed inpatient paediatric unit (with the ability to surge higher as needed). They attend all high-risk deliveries and participate in paediatric emergency room cases.

Outpatient services are delivered at the Chatham-Kent Child and Adolescent Clinic, a newly renovated space in downtown Chatham. All paediatricians share this space, which includes state of the art computing, a common electronic medical record, a conference room, personal office and exam room space for each doctor and experienced support staff. Space is available for the successful candidate to move in and share these exemplary facilities. Multidisciplinary clinics for asthma and diabetes are held on site. Opportunities exist for clinics in neighbouring communities such as Leamington, Wallaceburg and the Walpole Island First Nations Community.

There is a strong relationship with the Department of Paediatrics at the University of Western Ontario and opportunities for teaching both medical students and residents exists. All current paediatricians hold adjunct professor status at UWO.

About CKHA:

CKHA is a 200-bed hospital located in Southwestern Ontario that offers a full range of medical and diagnostic services including CT, MRI, and 24- hour laboratory, diagnostic imaging and respiratory therapy services. We also offer specialty services in Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine, ENT, Orthopaedic and General Surgery, Anesthesia, Psychiatry and OB/GYN.
