

Now Hiring: General Surgeon

Available Position:

Chatham-Kent Health Alliance (CKHA) has an immediate opportunity for a **General Surgeon Locum** to provide coverage during a medical leave. Other opportunities may develop for the position to become permanent. Candidates must be certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in General Surgery and must have an independent licence to practice surgery in Ontario. Experience is an asset, however, new graduates may be considered. ERCP certified, or willingness to become trained is essential. The locum will cover a turn-key, well established general surgery practice, and will join a team of 4 existing Surgeons.

Schedule and Compensation:

Practice includes 1 OR day per week, 1 day of Endoscopy per week, and 1 day of Ambulatory Care clinic per week in hospital. Call is 1 in 5. All call is eligible for HOCC payments. Compensation is fee for service, billed to OHIP. Come join us to build, grow and advance your career in a workplace where you will be respected and supported.
