Available Position:

Chatham-Kent Health Alliance (CKHA) has an immediate opportunity for a Hospitalist in our Medicine Department (part time and full time positions may be available). Our Hospitalists engage in a cohesive practice with an existing program composed of family medicine and internal medicine physicians, with no overhead or outside office/practice required. Responsibilities include providing in-patient medical care as MRP to approximately 15-18 acute medicine patients and rehab/complex continuing care patients with mid-level support.

CKHA is a 200-bed hospital located in Southwestern Ontario that offers a full range of medical and diagnostic services including CT, MRI, and 24- hour laboratory, diagnostic imaging and respiratory therapy services. We also offer specialty services in Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine, ENT, Orthopaedic and General Surgery, Anesthesia, Psychiatry and OB/GYN.
