Available Position:

Chatham-Kent Health Alliance (CKHA) has an opportunity for three (3) full time **Internists** in our Internal Medicine Department, which consists of 10 ICU beds and 12 PCU beds.

CAD/TIA clinics are shared by CKHA internists and therefore will be available approximately one day per week. Exercise and nuclear stress tests can be easily booked with our onsite ECG department. The internist on call reads all the ECGs within the 24 hour on call period. The option of reading PFTs and holters during that period also exists, with CKHA billing OHIP for these services on behalf of the internist.

About CKHA:

CKHA is a 200-bed hospital located in Southwestern Ontario that offers a full range of medical and diagnostic services including CT, MRI, and 24- hour laboratory, diagnostic imaging and respiratory therapy services. We also offer specialty services in Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine, ENT, Orthopaedic and General Surgery, Anesthesia, Psychiatry and OB/GYN.

Schedule and Compensation:

CKHA is excited to offer a unique opportunity to have a very busy practice, which will result in excellent compensation. Between on call days, ICU/PCU coverage, busy CAD/TIA clinics every week, office referrals from CKHA's emergency department and partnering family physicians in the community, the successful candidate will not struggle for work!

ICU and PCU are covered during the day via a weekly schedule comprised of all internists/subspecialists. Typically, an internist will cover ICU and PCU for a total of 6 weeks per year.

Internal Medicine calls 4-5 per month. All call is eligible for HOCC payments made directly to the physician. Opportunity also exists to participate in the stroke internist calls, which are eligible for a separate billing from the stroke network.
