Chatham-Kent Health Alliance (CKHA) has an immediate opportunity for a full-time **General Radiologist** in our Radiology Department. Candidates should be comfortable with a broad range of skills including the ability to interpret CT, MRI, US, fluoroscopy, x-ray, BMD and mammography. Non-vascular interventional experience, particularly with regards to biopsies and percutaneous catheter insertion is highly desirable. Additional fellowship training or experience in cardiothoracic imaging or breast imaging is an asset but not required. Candidates must possess exceptional interpersonal and collaborative skills, be dedicated to excellence in patient care, and be a strong team player. Canadian Royal College Certification and registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) is required.

About CKHA:

CKHA is a 200-bed hospital located in Southwestern Ontario that offers a full range of medical services including 24- hour laboratory, diagnostic imaging and respiratory therapy services. We also offer specialty services in Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine, ENT, Orthopaedic and General Surgery, Anesthesia, Psychiatry and OB/GYN.

Candidates can expect to find state-of-the-art facilities and a refreshed department with full PACS and recent and ongoing purchases of new US machines, a new CT scanner, new Nuclear Medicine SPECT/CT, new mammography unit with tomosynthesis, and a 1.5T MRI. On call diagnostic imaging interpretation is covered by a teleradiology group. CKHA is also affiliated with Western University's Distributed Education Network. We have a strong relationship with referral hospitals in London and Windsor, Ontario.
